



COVID-19 response

The Seventy-third World Health Assembly,

Having considered the address of the Director-General on the ongoing pandemic of coronavirus disease (COVID-19);¹

Deeply concerned by the morbidity and mortality caused by the COVID-19 pandsmic, the negative impacts on physical and mental health and social well-being the negative impacts on economies and societies and the consequent exacutation of frequenties within and between countries;

Expressing solidarity with all countries affected by the pandemic, as well as condolences and sympathy to all the families of the victims of COVID-19;

Underlining the primary responsibility of governments for adopting and implementing responses to the COVID-19 pandamic that are specific to their national context, as well as for mobilizing the necessary resources to do

Recalling the contributional mandate of WHO to act, inter alia, as the directing and coordinating authority on instructional leadth work, and recognizing the Organization's key leadership role within the broader United Nations response and the importance of strengthened multilateral cooperation in tacking the COVID-19 pandemic and its extensive negative impacts;

Recalling also that the Constitution of WHO defines health as a state of complete physical, mental and social well-being and nor merely the absence of disease or infirmity, and declares that the sujoyment of the highest attainable standard of health is one of the fundamental rights of every human being, without distinction of mas, religion, political belief, economic or social condition;

Further recalling the declaration of a Public Health Emergency of International Concern on novel coronavirus (2019-nCoV) on 30 January 2020 by the Director-General, and the temporary recommendations issued by the Director-General under the International Health Regulations (2005), upon the adults of the Emergency Committee convened in response to 2019-nCoV;

Also recalling the United Nations General Assembly resolutions 74-270 (2020) on global solidarity to fight the corenavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) and 74-274 on international cooperation to source global access to medicines, vaccines and medical equipment to face COVID-19.

"The Seventy-third World Health Assembly ... calls on Member States, in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic:

... to take measures to support access to safe water, sanitation and hygiene, and infection prevention and control, ensuring that adequate attention is paid to the promotion of personal hygienic measures in all settings, including humanitarian settings, and particularly in health facilities ..."



Scale-up a "culture of hand hygiene" in all settings

- HH is the first line of defense against transmission of infectious disease
- Provide universal access to public HH stations
- "No-regrets" investment
- Make HH obligatory in health care facilities, schools, workplaces, transport hubs, markets, and other public places
- Boost programs and partnerships




The Protocol on Water and Health


