Background

The Resident Coordinator's Office (RCO) in Turkmenistan has asked the United Nations Inter-Agency Issue-Based Coalition (IBC) on Environment and Climate Change for Europe and Central Asia for a targeted webinar on climate-migration nexus with specific focus on just transition and inclusive green growth in Turkmenistan.

UN Country Team (UNCT) is interested in enhancing their knowledge on climate-migration nexus and relevant global policy frameworks, specifically focusing on how climate change impacts human mobility and labour migration as well as good examples from different programme countries in terms of mainstreaming them into CF processes.

Representatives of ILO and IOM have kindly offered their time to deliver this webinar within the framework of the Coalition. The webinar will be recorded and made available to other UNCTs.
