

Kazakhstan: Disability inclusion as a pathway to urban resilience

- *Astana is engaged in MCR2030 since 2021*
 - Conducted 3 Scorecard assessments (2021–2022)*
 - Incorporated resilience in city strategic documents*
 - Joined MCR2030 and peer-learning exchange with Greater Manchester (2022)*
- *In 2023 pilot of Annex to the **Disaster Resilience Scorecard on Disability Inclusion** in Astana*
- *UN Disability Task Force in Kazakhstan supported the activity, feedback and expertise*
- *In 2024 this tool used in Almaty, Kazakhstan for city-level assessment of Inclusion*
 - *In line with the National efforts within UN Convention on people with disabilities*
- *Results contributed to the National Concept of Inclusive Policy until 2030*
 - *Direction 9: Inclusion in Emergency Management*
 - *UNDRR continuously supporting External Advisor to the Minister of Emergency Situations of Kazakhstan on inclusion*
